



Diamond Windows & Doors is happy to announce that we have recently received new NFRC test ratings on our 2000, 3000 and 6000 series windows based off of the recent changes we have made to our windows.

How does that affect me?

1. The new ratings allow our windows to qualify for the window tax credit included in the recently passed American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, otherwise known as the Stimulus Bill. Specifically, homeowners can earn 30% of the cost of their newly installed windows for up to \$1,500 in tax credits. To qualify for the tax credits, the windows must be placed in service" between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009 in the taxpayer's principal residence. The taxpayer will also need to retain our Manufacturer Certification Statement, which can be accessed through our website at www.DiamondWindows.com. They will be able to claim the tax credits by using IRS Tax Form 5695 (available late 2009 or early 2010).

2. Our 2000 Series double hung and slider windows, 3000 Series double hung, picture, and slider, and 6000 Series double hung, picture, and awning windows will all qualify for the aforementioned tax credits with the optional argon gas fill.

3. We also offer triple pane insulated glass options on our 2000, 3000 and 6000 Series windows. This option will qualify all window styles within the 2000, 3000, and 6000 Series for the tax credits regardless of argon gas fill or not.
